PATTERNS THAT POINT TO CHRIST

HEBREWS 7:1-3

MISSING JESUS

- The Old Testament points to Jesus from start to finish (Lk. 24:27, 32; 2 Tim. 3:15; Acts 17:11).
- It is a failure when we miss Jesus in the Old Testament (Lk. 24:25; Jn. 5:39-40, 46-47; Acts 7:51-53).

JESUS & MELCHIZEDEK

- The audience is rebuked for not being ready (Heb. 5:10-14).
- Everything in Hebrews 7 is from 3 verses (Gen. 14:18-20).
- The meanings of names are important (Heb. 7:2).
- Genealogies are important (Heb. 7:3).
- Fine details are important (Heb. 7:4).

JESUS THE ROCK

- The Rock was Christ (1 Cor. 10:4).
- There are two occasions where water comes from the Rock (Ex. 17:1-7; Num. 20:9-13).
- When the Rock is struck, the water of life comes forth (Isa. 50:6; 53:4).
- On the second occasion, Moses was commanded to speak, not strike (1 Jn. 1:9).
